


The Growing Importance of User-Friendly Technology

Maintaining strong relationships with sites is crucial to the success of any clinical trial. Reliable and prompt payment systems play an essential role in driving participant satisfaction and site efficiency. Sites need the ability to reimburse participants quickly and seamlessly, avoiding lengthy delays that can hinder trial progress. Additionally, site cash flow remains a concern, with 79% of sites reporting less than six months of operating capital available—a critical issue that underscores the importance of timely payments.*

100% of sponsors and CROs say payment to sites on a preferred and consistent basis is important in providing an optimal site experience.



Accelerating Study Startup

100% of sponsors and CROs say accelerating study startup (e.g., budgeting and negotiations) is important in providing an optimal site experience.




The Participant Experience

Tax Threshold Concerns

74% of U.S. sites believe that the current tax threshold of \$600 for clinical trial participant payments should be increased or eliminated. This threshold can create unnecessary complications and discourage participation.


